THE GOSPEL CHANGES EVERYTHING

It not only brings forgiveness of sins and a glorious eternal hope. It also *changes* us from within. We have a new identity in Christ and we are to live in a new way. Everything is to change: our view of self; our relationships; our marriages; our work; our responses to success and failure, tragedy and trial, challenge and change.

At our 2018 Annual Conference Dr Tim Lane, ably assisted by our seminar speakers, will be stirring us to greater gospel-driven change. He will be showing us how God has given us all the resources we need for real change. And he will show us how this works out in the context of common real-life issues such as anger, purity and anxiety.



Dr Tim Lane is the Founder and President of the *Institute for Pastoral Care*, a ministry that equips local churches to care for their people, and *Tim Lane & Associates*, a counselling practice located in Peachtree City, Georgia, USA. He is also a minister in the Presbyterian Church in America, having been ordained in 1991.

Tim has authored *Living Without Worry: How to Replace Anxiety with Peace*, and co-authored *How People Change* and *Relationships: A Mess Worth Making*. He has written several mini-books including *PTSD*, *Forgiving Others*, *Sex Before Marriage*, *Family Feuds*, *Conflict*, and *Freedom From Guilt*. He continues to write, speak and travel both nationally and internationally. He is also adjunct professor of practical theology at several seminaries where he teaches about pastoral care in the local church.
