Please join with us in praying for church planting and evangelism in this area. SGP partner churches in the BRIGHTON CLUSTER GROUP are shown on this map.

1	 BISHOP HANNINGTON CHURCH, HOVE (representative, Phil Moon) 1) for our young people's ministry, led by our Youth Minister, Stephen. This term they are looking at the Ten Commandments and 'Things that God can't do and why that's good news for you and me'. 2) for Phil as he takes a close look at our Bible teaching and training new leaders and preachers, with the aim of developing new and existing preachers and raising the quality of our Bible teaching. 3) for a sub-committee, set up by our PCC, to look at mental health and how we can sensitively raise awareness on the subject within the church, and be godly in our response.
	 GOLDSTONE CHURCH, HOVE (representative, Simon James-Morse) 1) for a growing prayer life; individually, as small groups, and as a whole church. 2) for a connection with the deaf community in Sussex – and to share God's love with them. 3) for a passion for mission; for the church to experience mission first-hand.

2	 CALVARY CHURCH, BRIGHTON (representative, Philip Wells) Give thanks for answered prayer in respect of a new Elder and new Deacon/Treasurer, Ben and David, respectively. Please pray for them as they take up their new responsibilities. Please now pray for a Deacon/Church Secretary to fill the vacant position. Give thanks for consolidation in partnership with other local churches in a similar location and situation to our own. We have begun praying regularly with New Life Church, Park Hill Evangelical Church, Ebenezer Baptist Church and the leaders of the initiative from the Association of Grace Baptist Churches as they seek to bring a fresh gospel input to Brighton. There is a huge need in central/east Brighton with tens of thousands of people with very few bible- teaching, gospel churches, to bring the good news to them. Please pray for the Lord of the harvest to send labourers into the harvest. for our own efforts to find a new lead-Pastor/Elder for future years. Elder, Chris, has received a diagnosis of terminal cancer, and Philip Wells is looking to hand over responsibilities in the next year or two.
	 NEW LIFE CHURCH, BRIGHTON (representative, Julian Rebera) 1) Relocation: New Life needs a new home! Our current venue is inadequate as we have more children than the venue can cope with. We are still a small church but it is space for the children and youth that is an issue. 2) Evangelism and Discipleship: This is ongoing. Please pray that the Lord would help us disciple those who have recently come to faith and that the one or two new regulars would be converted. Pray that we will effectively evangelise others. 3) Clubs: We are currently evaluating all our children's and youth work with a view to relaunching a new initiative. Please ask the Lord to provide all we need in terms of team members, leaders and vision.

3	 RICHARD JACKSON (Individual Partner, Bishop of Lewes) 1) for a good ending in Chichester Diocese as I move to be Bishop of Hereford in the new year. 2) for a godly, orthodox successor to be appointed. 3) that I will land well in Hereford, with wisdom to know the most effective way to get the Gospel out around the diocese.
	 WORTHING TABERNACLE (representative, Rich Owen) 1) for Alex and Delainey, our new American pastoral interns who came to us via AT3. Pray that they would settle in quickly and grow in their gifts and godliness. Pray for Alex in particular as he studies for his MTh via Union and shadows our pastoral team. 2) for us as we host a number of 321 courses and have lots of interest from our midweek toddler groups. Pray that many of those invited will come and that they will be saved. 3) for the Elders as they seek to lead the church forwards. All our ministries are stretched, yet we can see the great potential there is for growth. Pray for wisdom, that we'll be able to lead well and give clear gospel vision to the church family.
	 JULIAN HADDOW (Associate Partner, Brighton & Hove City Mission) 1) for the City Mission and its future. The finances (as with many charities) hang in a fine balance and we are looking to God to provide and guide us.

4	 ST LEONARD'S, DENTON (representative, Louis Wilson) 1) for our new babies' group which has been very well attended. Please pray for real Gospel fruit from it. Please also pray for an additional group for toddlers which we plan to start in January 2020. 2) for a planned programme of visiting and door-to-door evangelism. Please pray for our church family to have courage, faith and perseverance - and for encouragements. 3) for two brand new home-groups. Pray that they would enable deeper fellowship and practical encouragement.
	 PEACEHAVEN EVANGELICAL CHURCH (representative, Graham King) 1) for a new initiative, <i>Love Peacehaven</i>. We are printing 1000s of flyers to be delivered in the town, with a population of 25k. 2) for <i>Timothy connection</i>: a Saturday morning discipleship time for men, considering the next generation. 3) for us to reach families and keep new families coming into the church.

5	 AL PICKERING (Individual Partner, King's Church, Lewes) 1) Give thanks for a refreshing and inspiring sabbatical and pray for wisdom in implementing ideas gained from other churches. 2) for God to change lives through our Christmas evangelistic events: Wreath Making with short talk; Family Craft and Carols Saturday Morning; Traditional Carol Service. 3) for a greater sense of family and unity as a church, where people love one another, love being together and love drawing others in who don't know Jesus.
	 ST ANDREW'S, HOVE (representative, Dan Henderson) 1) for us as we run an Alpha Course for the first time in November/December. Pray for the building of a team with a heart for evangelism and particularly that local school parents might come along and find out more. 2) for safety, following a few structural issues with the church building, which might delay the reordering plans a bit. Pray that it doesn't distract from ministry.

6	 JOHN WOODS (Individual Partner, Lancing Tab) Praise God for a good summer of outreach at Messy Church and Space at the Table, which has resulted in two families coming to church weekly. Pray for more and for them to be converted. for John as he sets up the School of Preachers Trust, for which he will be working after February 2020. March to September look fairly busy in the UK, Latvia, Ukraine and Azerbaijan. for Lancing Tab in its search for a new Pastor. We are at the stage of exploring the possible suitability of a couple of candidates.
	 HOLY CROSS, HOVE (representative, Dave Howarth) 1) that our sermons and small group series in Exodus would have a lasting impact. 2) Thank God for about ten 1-to-1s now happening amongst the congregation. Ask God that these would help bring maturity. 3) for us as we look to take steps towards becoming a church all about disciple-making. Pray for wisdom, care and boldness.

8	 ARUNDEL BAPTIST CHURCH (representative, Steve Lomas) 1) for the Lord to provide musicians for our Sunday worship. 2) for an increase in people to support the ministry and work of the church, as many of our folk are elderly and struggling with age-related issues. The load falls on the few! 3) for our planned Christmas outreach programme which includes a Community Lunch and a Town Square Service.

9	 ANGMERING BAPTIST CHURCH (representative, David Barnes) 1) for a new initiative which began in October. We show a film on the second Saturday morning of the month as a form of outreach, and features include testimonies, apologetics and fictional narrative, among other genres. 2) for many of our congregation who are elderly and facing illness. Pray for improvement but also that they might have endurance and an assured hope in Christ. 3) for a special nativity service this year on Wednesday evening, 11 December. Our local Scouts group plays the various parts and their parents come to watch. There is also a message given. Please pray that this will be a fruitful form of outreach.
	 TOM ROBSON (Individual Partner, All Saints', Wick & St Mary Magdalene, Lyminster) 1) for the works on our hall to be completed, in order to provide more space and better facilities for our morning services. 2) for outreach opportunities over the autumn and winter, including a giant nativity retelling at Littlehampton 'Lights On'. 3) for the discipleship and encouragement of new believers and wisdom regarding how best to help them grow in faith.

DECEMBER 2019

Give thanks for a good number of people on the training courses:


