

Please join with us in praying for church planting and evangelism in this area. SGP partner churches in the BRIGHTON CLUSTER GROUP are shown on this map.

1	 BISHOP HANNINGTON CHURCH, HOVE (representative, Ben Martin) 1) for the appointment of our new vicar. Pray for someone who has a deep love for Jesus and his people. Pray that whoever is appointed will settle well into life here in Hove and be able to get to know the church family, and that we will welcome them well. 2) for ongoing fruit from our various Easter outreach training and events and for the Lord to bring new life in him. Pray that as a church family we would be encouraged and equipped to make Christ known wherever the Lord has placed us. 3) that throughout the summer and autumn months the church family will be united, more assured of the love of our Saviour and more confident in the good news of Jesus. Pray that this would overflow into all we do and are as a church.
	 HOLY CROSS, HOVE (representative, Dave Howarth) 1) Give thanks for home groups doing an <i>A Passion For Life</i> evangelism training session each month. Pray the result would be more evangelism and more disciples. 2) Give thanks for training sessions for all our small-group leaders, learning about discipleship. Pray that leaders would be sharpened in their understanding, and lead by example. 3) for the church to grow in love for the Lord, his people, and the lost, especially those who are somewhat cold in these areas.

2	 CALVARY CHURCH, BRIGHTON (representative, Philip Wells) 1) Give thanks for the Lord's continued sustaining over two particularly difficult years for our church. I have now moved to part-time paid service. We also have a part-time paid gospel-worker. 2) for continued guidance on the matter of 'future ministry' and a possible candidate for future pastor/elder with whom we spent time in May. 3) for provision for the ever-increasing administrative/statutory tasks. Our administrative assistant has played an immensely valuable role, but is now moving back to her homeland. 4) that in the midst of change we won't forget the opportunities and ministry of evangelism to our needy city.
	 MIKE JOURDAIN (Associate Partner, Brighton & Hove City Mission) 1) for our discussions with Brighton Council as we search for a new building to enable us to better support those in need in our city. 2) that our work in the food bank, care homes and schools will lead to people coming to faith in Jesus. 3) that we would continue to develop meaningful partnerships with churches.



4	 ST LEONARD'S, DENTON (representative, Louis Wilson) 1) for us as a church to keep the main thing the Gospel, and not to be distracted by perceived opportunities (and crises). 2) for wisdom as we implement aspects of a new Mission Action Plan. 3) for fruitfulness from the Marriage Course which we have started, and from a planned new monthly evening service.
	 PEACEHAVEN EVANGELICAL CHURCH (representative, Graham King) 1) for fruit from our evangelistic India Night event in April and our <i>A Passion for Life</i> Easter weekend meetings. 2) for our Christianity Explored course this summer. 3) for people's health in general. Lots of physical health problems, strokes, falls
	and viruses.

5	 OLI BUTLER (Associate Partner, UCCF) 1) for the Christian Unions at the universities, that they finish this academic year well. Ask the Lord to keep those on the fringe and new believers connected to local churches and in friendship with CU members. Pray for me as I come alongside them in that. 2) for the two new committees as my Relay Worker and I support them in their new roles and team dynamics. They'll be planning their new student welcome for the autumn term and putting together a strategy for the year ahead. 3) for me as I move on from being the UCCF Staff Worker in this patch. Pray that the Lord will enable a smooth handover to my successor and provide all that's needed (finances, wisdom and grace) for the ministry position I hope to start in August.
	 GRACE CHURCH, BRIGHTON (representative, Julian Rebera) 1) for people. We need workers to catch our vision and join us in our exciting mission to plant a Church Planting Church. Please pray that as well as praying for us, some would be really radical and join us. 2) for a venue. This has been a massive challenge - we need a real breakthrough. We really want to be meeting somewhere on the Lewes Road by September. Please ask the Lord to grant to us a highly visible, highly accessible, highly attractive and highly functional (fit for purpose) venue. I know - we don't want much! But we need every advantage we can gain. 3) for logistics. We are still working through setting up a charity, transferring assets and need to purchase a property and raise funds for a trainee. The Lord knows we need His help - please pray!

6	 AL PICKERING (Individual Partner, King's Church, Lewes) 1) Give thanks for new Christians in the church and pray for them to grow as disciples of Jesus. 2) for our emphasis on Growing as Disciples and Growing Together over the coming year. 3) for me and our elders team with Rich, our senior pastor, on sabbatical from June to September.
	 ST ANDREW'S, HOVE (representative, Dan Henderson) 1) for our PCC as we continue to engage with the Church of England's <i>Living in</i> <i>Love and Faith</i> resources, addressing the issues of identity, sexuality, relationships and marriage. It's a subject which the church hasn't been used to thinking about. 2) for our re-ordering team as this year will be when the hard work of planning and applying for funding is done. 3) for a small group looking at youth and children's work in our church and how we can invest in our young people, potentially through staffing.

	 RICHARD BRUNTON (Associate Partner, Living Hope Ministries & member of Lancing Tab) 1) for Andrew in the Ukraine, Rasheed in Pakistan and Daniel in the Congo. Pray for God's protection and courage to proclaim Christ. 2) for me as I preach several times each week through media and at UK churches that support Living Hope Ministries. Pray for the right word to be delivered at the right time. 3) that my wife and I will be effective in serving our local church.


AUGUST




