- 3) for us as we work through how to prioritise people rather than programmes. Please pray that we will all grow a deeper relationship with God, and each other, through this process.





We welcome men and women of all ages who hold evangelical convictions and desire to serve Christ in their particular context.






Fees (2022/2023) £225 per term (£675 for the year)

Sussex Ministry Training Course (SMTC)


