- 3) that we might be a church which is welcoming and accessible for all kinds of people, especially those we serve from the community with our mercy ministries. Pray they might come to know Jesus.




WORTHING TABERNACLE (Representative, Rich Owen)





We welcome men and women of all ages who hold evangelical convictions and desire to serve Christ in their particular context.






Fees £245 per term (£735 for the year)


